Terms of Reference

Purpose:

The Working Party aims to renew or restore the play equipment and benches at "The Glebe".

Scope:

The Working Party will investigate all matters concerning The Glebe and benches, reporting back to full Council with recommendations only.

The Working Party can only fact -find and recommend.

Membership:

Includes Killinghall Parish Councillors, public members, and local community groups, up to 10 members.

A Chair and Vice-Chair will be elected by the membership

Invited Guests:

The Working Party can invite guests to Working Part Meetings to aid within the scope of the Terms of Reference, such as the local play equipment providers.

Meeting Arrangements:

Meetings can be held as often as desired:

- Are not open to the public,
- Do not require an agenda.
- Notes must be kept.
- Meetings can be face-to-face or via Zoom/Team

Budget:

The Working Party has a budget of £100.00 which will be approved by Killinghall Parish Council prior to any expenditure for items such as:

Booking a room for a Working Party Meeting.

Photocopying information for the membership.

Any expenses will only be reimbursed will receipts and the decision of the reimbursement will be the decision of Killinghall Parish Council.

Reporting:

To report to Killinghall Parish Council monthly.
